1. Brief background of the college:

Kohima College, a premier educational institution in the state of Nagaland, located in the scenic hillock of Kruoliezou, was established on the 9th August 1967. The college holds the distinction of being the first private college offering higher education in Arts Stream for the first time in Kohima. It is affiliated to Nagaland University and offers three year undergraduate degree courses in a multitude of Humanities programs. The Commerce stream was successfully introduced in 2016. The government of Nagaland took over Kohima College with effect from 1st February 2006. The present campus covers a total area of 28.27 acers. Kohima College has successfully completed two cycles of assessment (2012 and 2017) by the National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC) Bengaluru and graded B and B+ respectively. The college with its motto 'Search for Excellence' aspires not only to promote quality education but also to inculcate an awareness of fair play, honesty and integrity among the students, motivating them to lead bold, engaged and transformed that will add value to our shared community.
