- 4. To organize exclusive Talks for respective genders, i.e., 'Girls Talk' for female students and 'Boys Talk' for Male students. The topics to be tackled ranges from Sexuality, Teenage Pregnancy, Menstrual Health, Personal Hygiene, Responsibilities and Identity
- 5. To observe the International Day for Elimination of Violence against Women on 25th November and International Women's Day on 8th March through, creative activities like Essay Competition, Walkathon, Poetry Slam, Signature Campaign, Flash Mobs etc.
