
CLAUSE 1 CO-OPERATION

- 1. CLAUSE 2 SCOPE OF THE MoU






- 4. Entrepreneurship Development Programs: Second Party to train the students of First Party on the emerging business skills in order to bridge the skill gap and make them future ready.

CLAUSE 4 VALIDITY

- 1. This Agreement shall be valid until it is expressly terminated by either Party on mutually agreed terms, during which period Name of Industry, the Second Party, as the case may be, shall take effective steps for implementation of this MOU. Any act on the part of Training Partner or Name of Industry, the Second Party after termination of this Agreement by way of communication, correspondence etc., shall not be considered as an extension of this MOU.
- 2. Both Parties may terminate this MOU upon 30 calendar days' notice in writing. In the event of Termination, both parties have to discharge their obligations.
