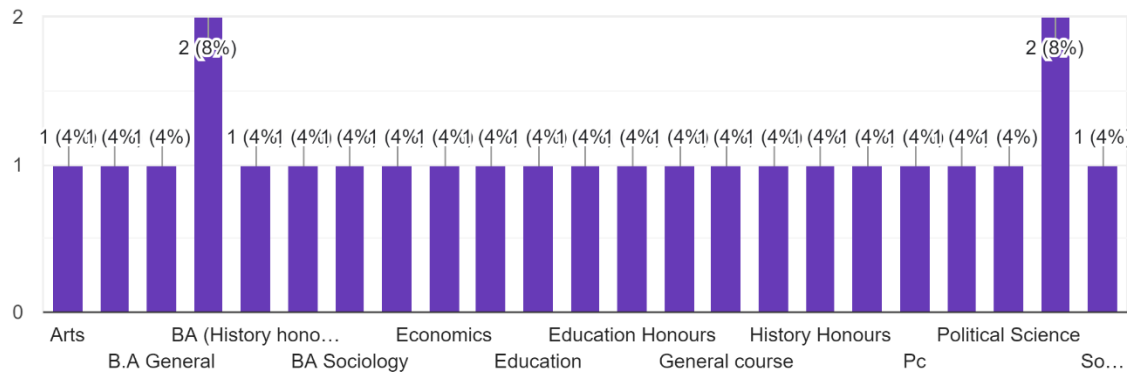

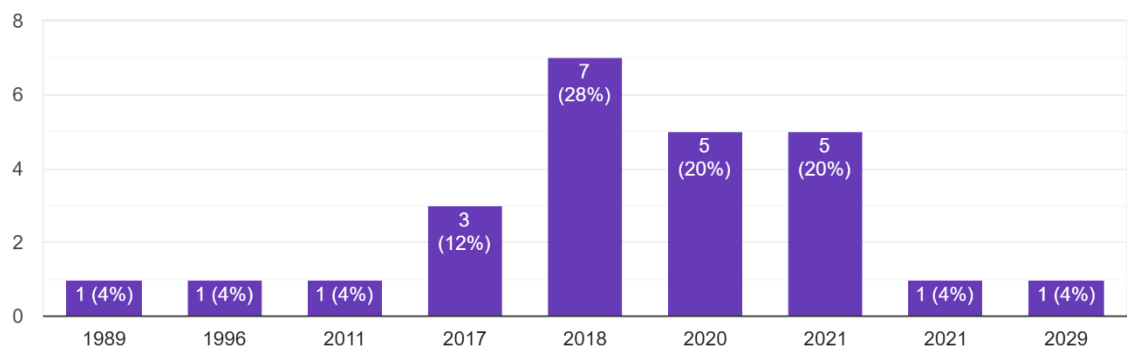
Course Opted

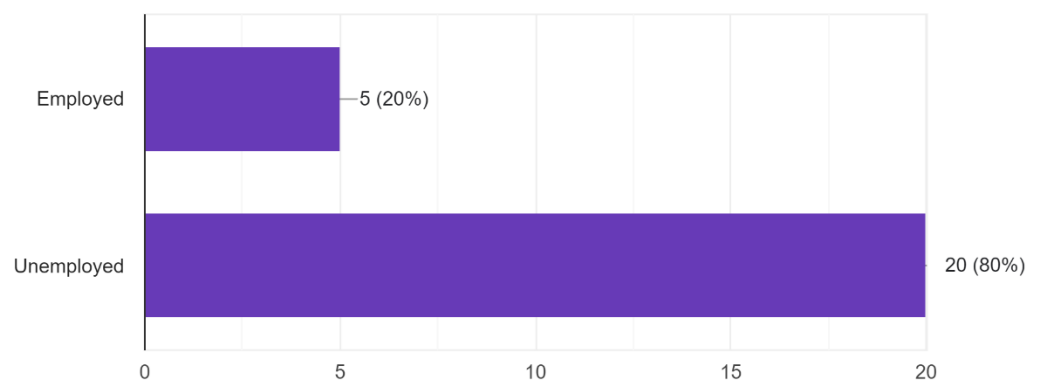
Year of Completion of Course

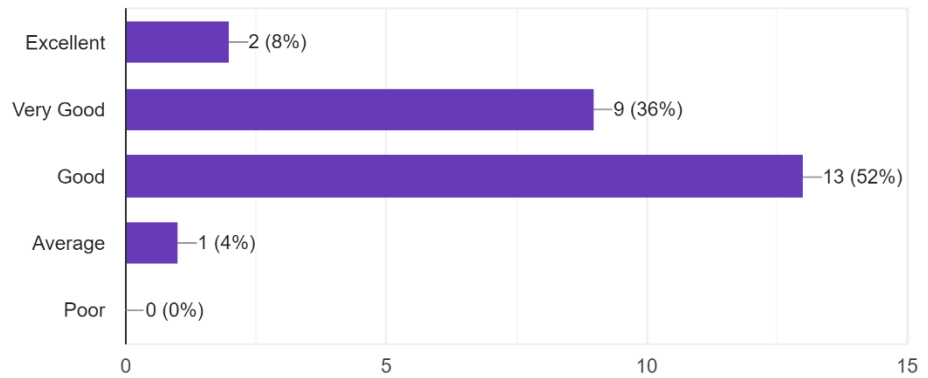

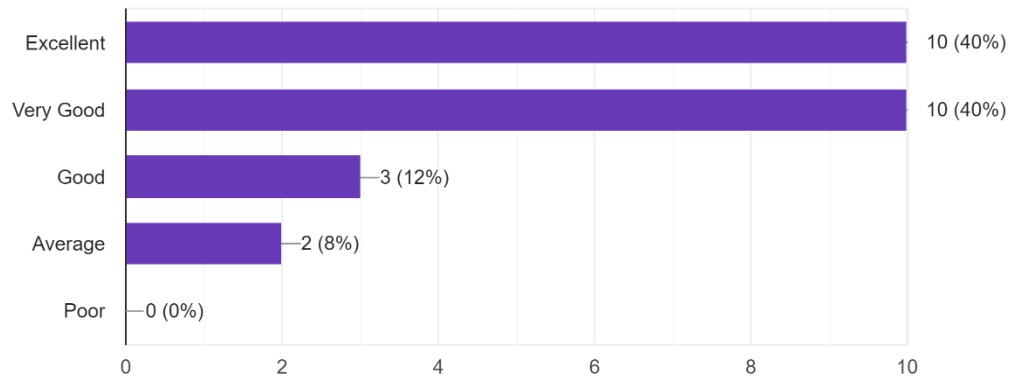

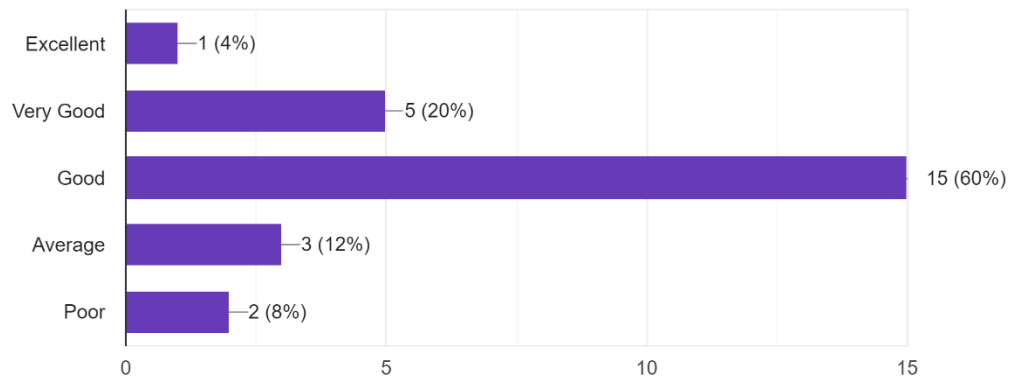

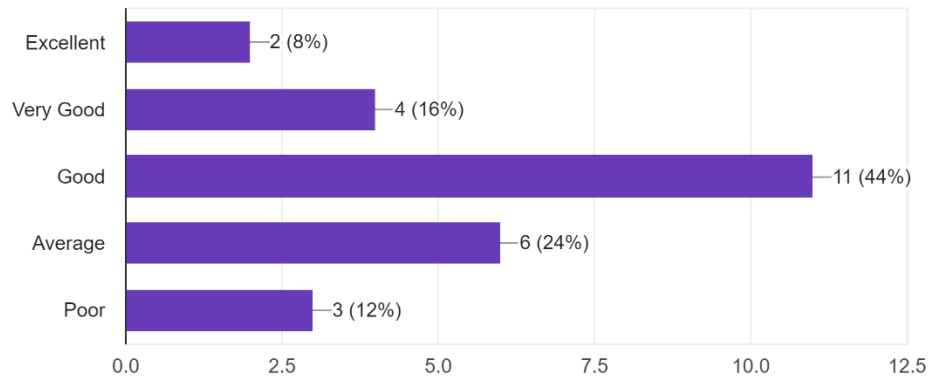

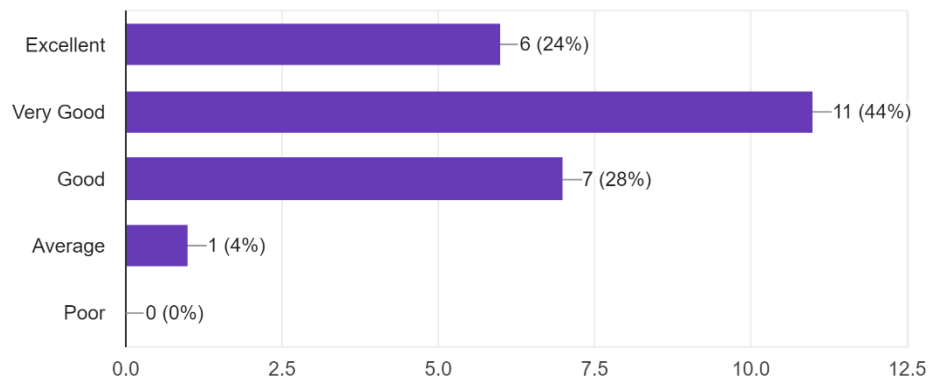
Admission Procedure

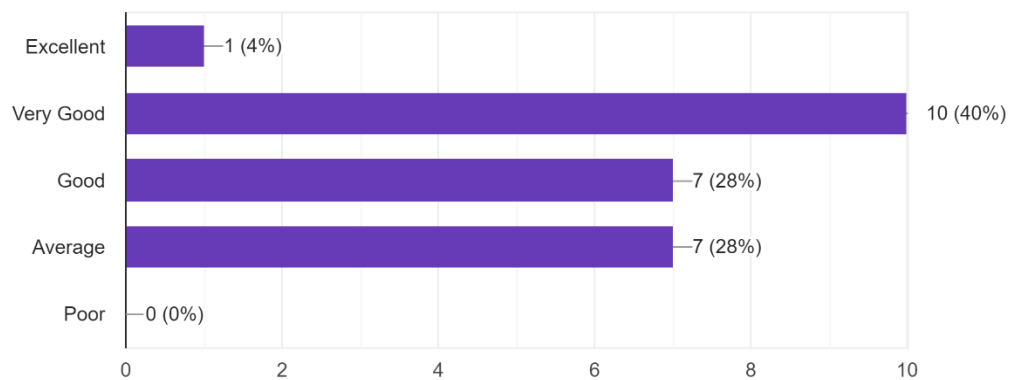
Fee structure

Analysis of Alumni Feedback Form (2021-2022)

On Administration and Faculty: Regarding the functioning of the college administration and faculty, the alumni responses were positive. A few recommendations were made with regard to admission and filling up of forms. The respondents appealed that the office staff be more approachable and communicative and to give out proper information to the students.

On Teaching and Learning: The alumni suggested for better communication and consideration for the students. An alumnus hoped to see “KCK students with better internal marks in the near future”. Another respondent wished that the teachers would consider the needs and difficulties of the students and to give more marks to students who are more deserving. Another suggested for more interaction session for students and lectures.

Suggestions were placed for distance learning and morning/evening shifts for working students.

On Curriculum: About 68% of the respondents were satisfied with the courses offered in college in relation with their current job/occupation. They encouraged more extra-curricular activities for the students and also to focus on skill and career-oriented activities such as sports, arts, business, etc.

One alumnus expressed the need to “enlarge the facilities and reorganize the curriculum, for a better college in the future. Another alumnus hoped that the college will not only impart course related education and provide degree, but will “also empower young minds to be skilled enough during their three years with various co curriculums and to carry forward those education and become an independent generation “.

On Facilities: The respondents wished for a better college environment and compound.

On Kohima College Alumni: 1.To host annual alumni programs
2. Activate, Engage, Involve the alumni for larger interest and development of the college as well as for the welfare of the students’ community.

Others: 1.Provide better bus service for students.
2. Provide proper uniform from head to toe and to change the colour of the college blazer.
