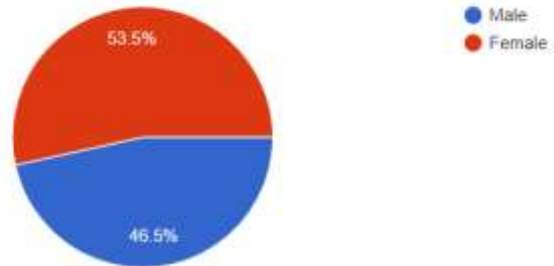

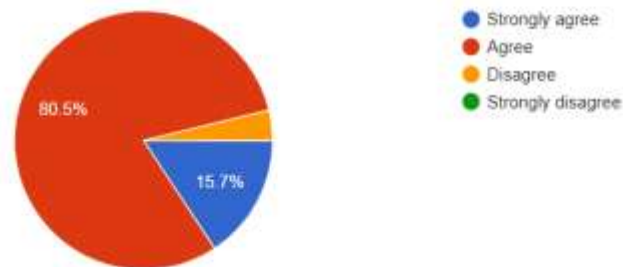

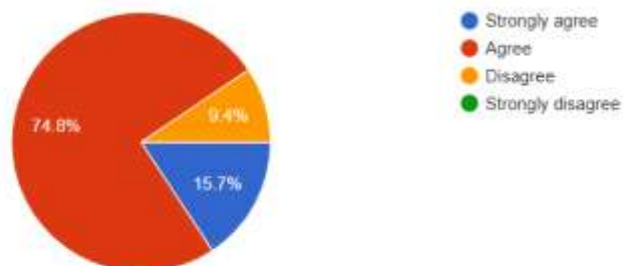


Curriculum

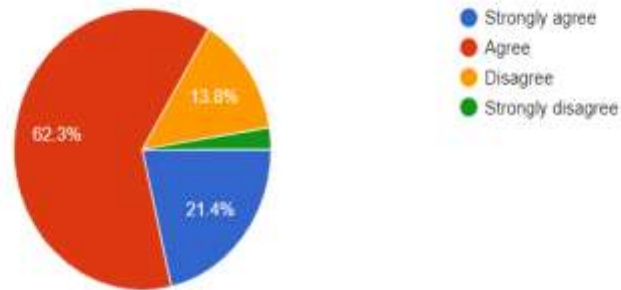
1. The curriculum meets the learning needs of the students



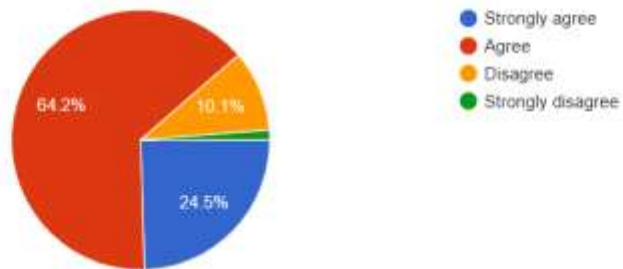
2. The Curriculum provides the students with opportunities to learn and thrive in the 21st Century



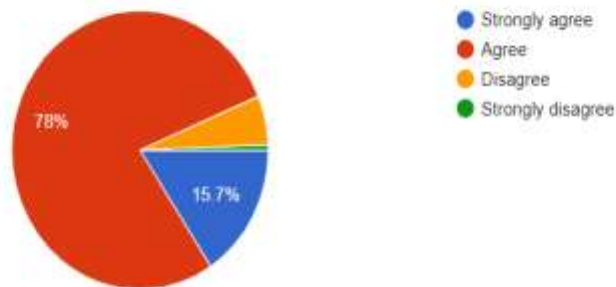

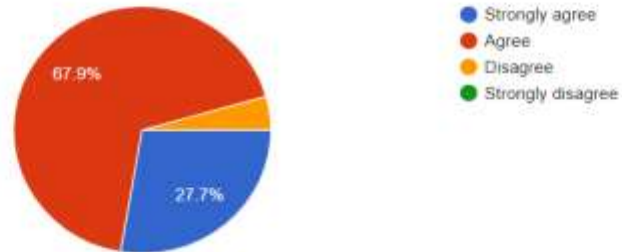

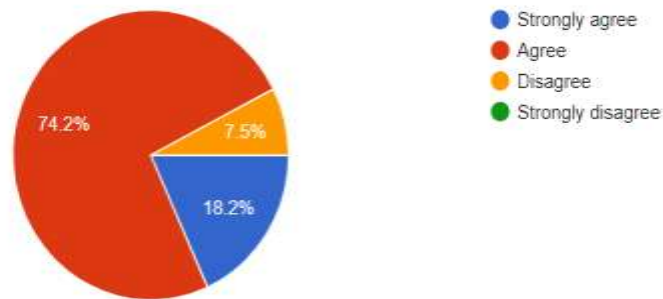


Teaching and Learning

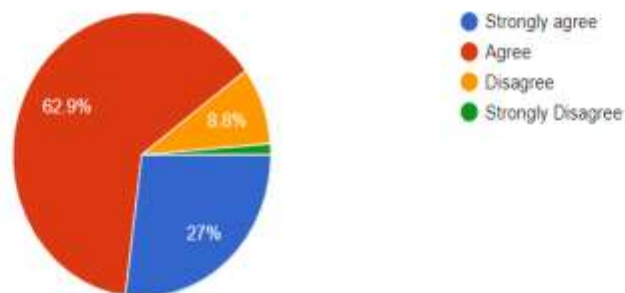
1. Teachers are competent, committed and have sufficient skills to teach the curriculum



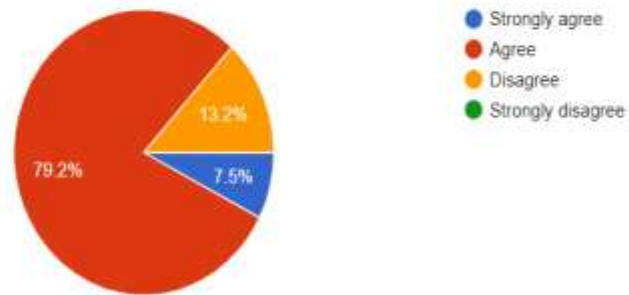

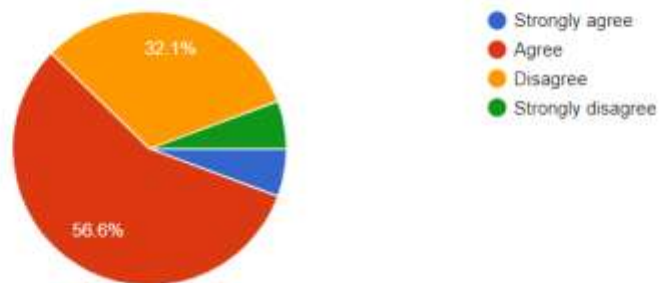
1. The College has a supportive environment for students' well-being.



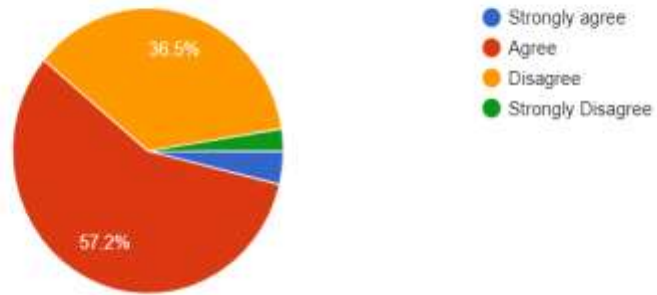
2. The college premises are clean and well-maintained.



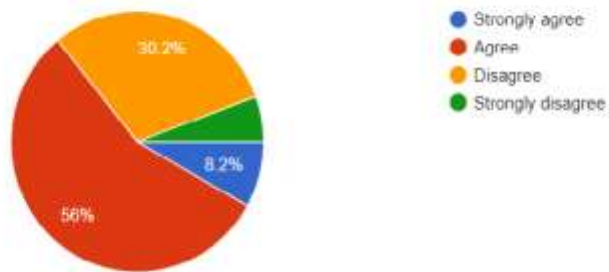
3. The College provides safe drinking water.



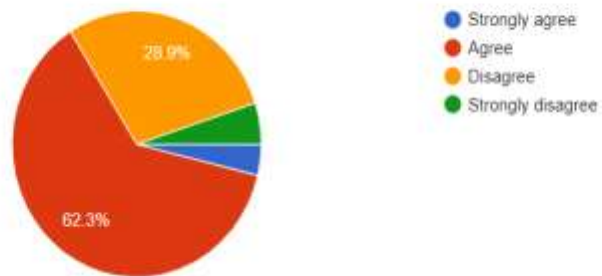
4. The College provides good healthcare.



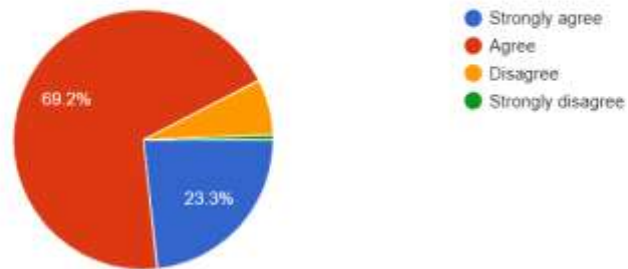
5. The college has good canteen facilities.



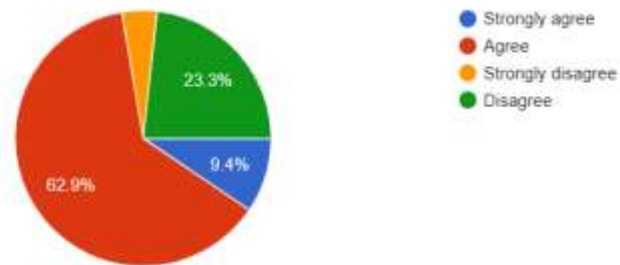
6. College addresses students' grievances and issues immediately.



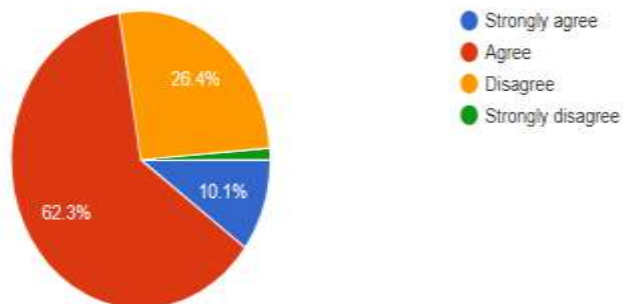
7. College activities outside the classroom help students to develop their social and leadership skills

Some Complaints and Recommendations.

1. Quite a good number of students expressed the need for more optional subjects. To this end, the college authority has written a number of times to the government of Nagaland for introduction of more subjects in the under graduate level as well as for introduction of PG courses in History, Pol.science and English.
2. Provision for more washrooms for students is being done. Principal has also written to higher authorities to sanction additional funds for the same
3. The Student's Welfare committee has been entrusted to look into the menace of tribalism in the college especially with regard to the Student's Council election.
4. Shortage of college bus is another pressing problem faced by the students. The Directorate of Higher Education, govt of Nagaland has been reminded time and again to allot more buses to the college.
5. The peons and sweepers under the supervision of the Swachh Bharat Cell will see that toilets are cleaned everyday and sufficient water provided.
6. Teachers have been notified to judiciously use the class timing allotted and also to follow classroom etiquette.
