Course Name	Course Objectives
HIS 101 History of India up to the Mauryas	To familiarize the students with the socio-economic developments in India from Pre historic period up to the downfall of the Maurya Empire.
HIS 201 History of India – Post Maurya to Delhi Sultanate	To acquaint the students with the history of this period with special stress on socio-economic and cultural developments.
HIS 301 History of India 1526 to the 19 th century	To know the trends and developments in India during the Mughal and the British periods.
HIS 401 Indian Nationalism	The students will learn the origins of Indian nationalism and the history of India's freedom struggle.
HIS 501 History of Europe	To introduce the students to some of the major developments in the world from the decline of the feudal age to the French Revolution.

HIS 601 Modern World	The students will learn about some significant developments in the modern world from the period of the two world wars to the cold war era.
HIS 101 Honours History of North East India 1822-1972	The students will be introduced to the political and the socio-cultural developments in this region under the British rule.
HIS 202 East Asia 1840-1950	The students will learn about the political, socio-economic developments and the European expansion and nationalistic movements in East Asia.
HIS 302 History of India AD 1550-1750	With special focus on social and economy, this course is intended to familiarize students with the various developments during the Mughal period.
HIS 402 History of the United states of America	The purpose of the paper is to introduce the students to the history of the United States from colonial days to world war II.
His 502 History of Christianity in Nagaland	The students will be introduced to the history of Christianity in Nagaland from its beginning up to 1972.
His 503 Social and Economic history of Modern India.	This paper will provide a general understanding of social changes and economic developments in India from the 18 th to the 20 th century.
HIS 602 Political history of the Nagas.	Through this paper the students are expected to become acquainted with the political history of the Nagas from the Pre colonial period up to the formation of the state of Nagaland.
HIS 603 Historiography	This course will help the students to understand some basic fundamental concepts that make up the subject matter of the discipline of history.
